 - Address staffing shortages by allowing psychiatric nurse practitioners to aid clinicians.
 - Develop more housing of all kinds (affordable, supportive, and market rate)
 - Increase interagency collaboration.
 - Increase opportunities for treatment in communities.

A recent poll by the Association for a Better New York found that 91% of New Yorkers believe it more compassionate to compel treatment and care for people with severe mental illness than it is to abandon them on streets.
